

How to e-record your documents.

- 1. **Open** your web browser and navigate to http://okaloosaclerk.com
- 2. When the website opens, CLICK on "DEPARTMENTS"
- 3. HOVER over "RECORD SERVICES" for a side-menu to open
- 4. CLICK on e-Recording to open the e-recording information page.




 Scroll halfway down the webpage until you see "e-RECORDING DOCUMENTS" and CLICK on <u>TYLER DIRECT ACCESS e-RECORDING</u>. (see image below)



- 6. After clicking on <u>Tyler Direct Access e-Recording</u>, you will be re-directed to Okaloosa County's e-Recording website hosted by Tyler Technologies.
- 7. Once the page has opened (Tyler Direct Access e-Recording) You have 2 options.
 - 1. If this is your first time e-filing, you will want to take the <u>tutorial</u> which walks you through registering for an account and will also walk you through submitting your first documents for e-recording.

If you have already registered for an account and viewed the <u>tutorial</u>, you will want to click on **GET STARTED** to start e-recording your documents.
