

Permit Guide for Residential Swimming Pool

Department of Growth Management

Swimming pools, hot tubs and similar uses are allowed in any front, side, or rear yard provided the following required setbacks can be met:

1.. Five (5) feet from the edge of the pool water to any side or rear property line;

NOTE: If the pool is to be enclosed, a separate permit is required for the enclosure.

2. Front setbacks shall conform to the front minimum building setback for the zoning district in which the pool is located setbacks are measured from the edge of the pool water to a front property line;

NOTE: If the swimming pool will be enclosed, you must provide the setbacks from the proposed enclosure to the waters edge of the pool. The enclosure must meet the building setbacks for the zoning district it is located in.

Safety Feature Options

In order to pass a final inspection and receive a certificate of completion a residential swimming pool must comply with Chapter 424 of the Florida Building Code.

Submittal Requirements Checklist:			
1	Proof of property ownership. This can be a recorded deed, closing statement, or property tax information.		
2	Two sets pool plans.		
	Plans must include all safety feature options, and piping systems.		
3	_ Building Permit Application. The application must be fully completed, signed, and notarized.		
4	Two copies of a certified survey or site plan.		
5	Private Swimming Pool Safety Requirements form.		

*Some circumstances may require additional information to be submitted prior to a development permit being issued.
